

Haywood Academy Uniform and Equipment List September 2025

We have very high standards at Haywood Academy and this includes our uniform policy. We want our students to look smart and be proud of our uniform in school and in our community.

Please see below for full details of our uniform:

Academy Uniform

Item	Description (Colour and style)
Haywood Academy	The school blazer is black with the Haywood Academy logo embroidered on. The blazer should
branded blazer	not be tight fitting and the sleeves must not be rolled up. If a student outgrows a blazer during a
	school year, a new one will need to be purchased. Students will not be allowed to attend
	lessons without a blazer.
	On days when the weather is hot, the Academy will make a decision on a daily basis as to
	whether students can remove their blazers for the duration of the day; however, students must
	bring their blazers to school every day.
Haywood Academy	This item is optional.
branded jumper	
	The school jumper is currently navy with the Haywood logo embroidered on. The jumper can
	only be worn underneath the Academy blazer (it is not an alternative) during the winter months
	(Oct-Feb). Sleeves must not be rolled up.
	If a student outgrows a jumper during a school year or develops holes/rips, a new one will need
	to be purchased.
Trousers	Trousers must be plain black, full length tailored trousers. They will be conventional in style (i.e.
	straight leg) and not made of stretchy fabric.
	Skinny, oversized, baggy, flared, cropped, ribbed/patterned, fashion trousers, jeans or leggings
	are not part of the Haywood Academy uniform.
	Please see examples below of trousers which are allowed.
Shirt	Shirts must be white, conventional school style, short or long sleeve and fasten at the neck.
	These must be loose fitting. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Polo shirts are not allowed.
	Bras must not be brightly coloured, so they do not show through the white shirt.
Tie	Clip on tie for all students. Parent/carers are recommended to purchase spare ties in case of
	loss or damage. Ties must be clipped on at the top of the shirt.
Socks	Socks must be plain black.
Shoes	Must be plain black with a black sole, in polishable leather, leather look or patent type shoe.
Outside coat	Please note that the whole of the upper part of the shoe (above the sole) must be all black, all
	leather and all polishable with no logos/tags/names. Trainer style shoes/pumps, regardless of
	the retailer description, are not allowed. Canvas or fabric shoes are not allowed. Medical
	information can be provided to the Academy if alternative footwear is needed.
	Plain (i.e. no buckles, laces, fur) black leather ankle boots may be worn. These should be
	'Chelsea' style only. Doc Marten, work style boots, for example are not allowed. Trousers must
	be worn over boots.
	Please see some attached examples of permitted and non-permitted footwear. Please note that
	shoes are required at all times of the school year; if students outgrow a pair of shoes or the
	shoes become damaged, parents/carers will be required to purchase a new pair of shoes.
	Any sensible style or colour suitable for school.
	No denim or leather. No badges or emblems except maker's motif. Sweatshirts, hooded tops
	and track suit tops are not acceptable as coats and must not be worn. Coats cannot be worn
	instead of a blazer; the coat is optional, but the blazer is mandatory.
	Coats must not be wern when inside the Academy buildings
	Coats must not be worn when inside the Academy buildings.

Academy PE kit

Item	Description (Colour and style)
Haywood Academy branded sports top	The Academy sports top is navy and must be worn for all PE and Dance lessons. No other sports tops are allowed.
	If a student outgrows a sports top during a school year, a new one will need to be purchased irrespective of how long is left of the academic year; students will not be allowed to take part in PE lessons without the PE top. Students will need to borrow Academy sports wear if they arrive at their lessons without kit.
Shorts	Shorts must be plain navy with no stripes, labels or logos on them. Alternative PE wear is listed below for those students who do not wish to wear shorts. Cycling shorts are not allowed.
	Additional optional items:
	 Haywood Academy branded skins/leggings ONLY. No other items/leggings are allowed. Haywood Academy branded skort
	Haywood Academy branded track pants
	Haywood Academy ¼ zip performance jumper
Trainers	Any design or colour trainers (with a rubber sole) are permissible. Pumps (i.e. Converse, VANS) are not allowed.
Football boots and shin pads	Are allowed on the Sports field only. Students will be directed to bring football boots/shin pads by their PE teacher.

Other items

Item	Description (Colour and style)
Jewellery	Students are allowed one single plain gold or silver stud in each ear; the stud must be worn in
	the lower part of the earlobe and must be removed for PE. Hoops, spacers or earrings of any
	other kind are not allowed. If a student is found to be wearing more than one stud per ear or
	an earring that is not a stud, the student will be required to remove it.
	Students are allowed to wear a wrist watch. Smart watches are not allowed.
	Nose studs; metal or ringed piercings are not allowed, a small, clear plastic retainer is permitted.
	No other piercings or jewellery are allowed (e.g. rings, bracelets and necklaces).
	If you are unsure, we recommend that you ask in advance to check what is permissible.
Make-up	Only light make-up is allowed. This should be natural and lightly applied. Excessive make-up, as
	determined by the school, is not allowed and students will be asked to remove it. False
	eyelashes are not allowed.
Nails	Nails should be kept short and natural in colour. False nails, nail art, nail extensions, coloured
	nail polish is not allowed. Students will be asked to remove them.
Hair	Hairstyles must be plain and practical for school. There should be no extreme or fashion styles
	including steps, lines, shaved styles, elaborate braiding or non-natural hair colouring. Hair must
	be of a natural colour. Any hair extensions/braids etc must also be of a natural colour.
	Extreme hairstyles, colours or novelty accessories (unless there is a special request to the
	Principal, or there is an organised Academy event) are not allowed.
	Long hair should be tied back in a bobble in PE, Dance and Technology.
Hats and caps	Students must not wear a hat, cap or durag whilst on the Academy school site. The Academy is
	fully committed to equality and diversity and religious headwear such as the hijab is allowed. If

Item	Description (Colour and style)
Non-Uniform Days	We would like to remind students that it is privilege to come into the Academy in their own clothes on a non-uniform day; it is still a normal day and students are required to bring in all the necessary equipment for a normal day; this would typically include: a bag, PE kit if the student has PE that day, appropriate footwear for school, any stationery such as pens, a green pen for marking, mathematics equipment etc.
	Below is a list of items that are not acceptable on a non-uniform day. We would like to be clear that this is not an exhaustive list. If we do deem a student to be in inappropriate clothing, we will contact parents/carers and ask for suitable clothing to be brought into the Academy. Prohibited items of clothing:
	 Crop-tops or any other item of clothing where a student's midriff is not covered Tops or other items of clothing that expose a bra or other underwear Offensive imagery/language Inappropriate imagery Baseball caps and other hats Crocs/sliders High heels
	Piercings, jewellery, make-up, hair colour and style – exactly the same as any other day; please see above.

Equipment List

To ensure our students are ready for learning, they will need to ensure that they are fully equipped when they arrive at the Academy. Students will be provided with paper, exercise books, paper, textbooks as needed but will need to carry all equipment with them for the day. Please make sure that students have the following with them every day:

- An appropriate bag to accommodate A4 books and all their equipment (students that arrive at the academy without this, will be required to use one of our yellow loan bags for the day)

- Calculator (optional)
